The Paul P. Haas Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes an individual member who demonstrates excellence in leadership, playing a pivotal role in the overall operations leading to organizational success.

### **Eligible Nominees:**

A CEO, executive director, board member, benefactor, or trustee in a member community

### **Criteria:**

- History of commitment, leadership, and involvement with broad-reaching impact for the advancement of serving older adults.
- Significant involvement in advocacy and grassroots initiatives to support aging services at the state and/or national level.
- Successful contributions to improving quality and fostering a better community-wide understanding of aging services.
- Distinguished record of service and support to the LeadingAge PA vision and mission.
- Outstanding leadership that resulted in the advancement of specific goals and objectives of the community.

### **Application Requirements:**

- One nomination letter, not exceeding two pages, that outlines the nominee's qualifications and manner in which the nominee meets the award criteria.
- Three letters of reference from relevant sources that can speak to the nominee's accomplishments.

### **Optional Application Items:**

- Submission of support collateral.
- Additional letter(s) of reference.
