



VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

The Volunteer of the Year Award recognizes an individual or group that enhances the quality of life for older adults through volunteer work.

Eligible Nominees:

Resident or non-resident, individual or group volunteer(s) from a member community

Criteria:

- Significant volunteer service hours within a member community.
- Extraordinary dedication to promoting the dignity, well-being, and independence of community members.
- Impact and level of service that inspires a positive community environment.

Application Requirements:

- One nomination letter, not exceeding two pages, that outlines the nominee's qualifications and manner in which the nominee meets the award criteria.
- Two letters of reference from relevant sources that can speak to the nominee's accomplishments.

Optional Application Items:

- Submission of support collateral.
- Additional letter(s) of reference.
