LeadingAge PA's Fellows in Leadership program is a nine-month, immersive program that focuses on effective leadership practices. You will gain the skills, confidence, and support to enact true change to impact your real-world challenges.

- Learn how leaders become more authentic through exploration of personal strengths, values, and their own leadership philosophy and practices.
- Explore and discuss one's own strengths and styles using the Everything DiSC Work of Leaders assessment and learning activities.
- Understand what motivates and inspires people at work.
- Discover the ways in which emotional and cultural intelligence enhances leadership performance.
- Learn the components of leadership required to transform the future of aging services.
- Interact with experienced leaders from the aging services community, engage in small group cohorts, and participate in interactive learning experiences.
- Develop a network of colleagues among LeadingAge PA members.
- Exclusive opportunities through the Fellows Alumni Council and the Fellows Mentoring Program.

LeadingAge PA's Fellows in Leadership program explores leadership challenges faced by today's leaders and the tools and techniques that can be used to overcome them.



CURRICULUM

Fellows in Leadership is an evolving program based on the emerging needs of long-term care leaders.

The program emphasizes self-awareness and relationship building through a variety of education methodologies. Traditional and experiential learning methods are used to create an environment in which Fellows learn from their own experiences, from one another, from the coaches and design team, and from leaders and experts in the field.

Fellows participate in group discussions and exercises, site visits, virtual meetings, meet with leaders in the field, and complete reading and other assignments including a Learning Lab.

- Collaborate with a small cohort of emerging leaders alongside an established mentor
- Learn from and interact with industry leaders from across the state
- Connect with past Fellows and LeadingAge PA board members through networking events

CORE THEMES INCLUDE:

Leadership and self-reflection, fostering a good culture and team engagement, strategic thinking, and work/life integration.

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ELIGIBILITY

The Fellows in Leadership program is available to anyone who works for a LeadingAge PA member, who is currently supervising at least one direct report. It is far more important for potential LeadingAge PA Fellows to demonstrate deep leadership potential within their organizations than it is for them to carry specific job titles. Diversity is a core value of the program.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Class size is limited. All application submissions will be reviewed to ultimately assemble a diverse class in life experience, leadership roles, geography, type of organization, as well as other unique characteristics. A committee of LeadingAge PA member leaders and association staff will evaluate applications based on:

- How well defined, insightful and introspective are the leadership essays?
- How well does the applicant demonstrate a personal commitment to the field of aging services?
- To what extent does the applicant possess the leadership capacity needed to become a transformational leader?

TUITION

- A \$2,500 tuition payment (non-refundable and non-transferable) is required from each LeadingAge PA Fellow's organization. Lodging, travel expenses, and some meals are also paid for by the Fellow's organization. The costs incurred vary depending on the locations of the site visits.
- The tuition fee includes the cost of journals, materials, evaluations, assessments, and some meals during Fellows in Leadership in-person sessions.
- One complimentary day at the 2024 LeadingAge PA Annual Conference equal to the Member Early Bird, Tuesday Only, rate.

LeadingAge PA will award one Ron Barth Scholarship for the 2024 Fellows in Leadership program.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Application must be completed online by June 25, 2023. Applicants will receive notification of their acceptance status by August 9, 2023.
